

#### Arbitron Nationwide M-Su 6a-Mid 12+ Persons Using Radio AQH Rating Spring Quarter 1980-2008





## Doctrine

- Miami Herald Publishing Co. v. Tornillo, 1974
  - Florida had a law similar to the Fairness Doctrine for print media
  - Court held that the law was unconstitutional content regulation
- FCC v. League of Women Voters, 1984
  - The Public Broadcasting Act of 1967 allocated federal funds to noncommercial tv and radio but prohibited editorializing on the stations
  - Court held that the law was unconstitutional






## Limbaugh's 2015 paycheck - \$79M


