








The future of radio




BMW and Tesla are eliminating broadcast AM radio

The future of radio

- It's much of what we've always wanted
- Personal
 - A DJ or performer who knows what I like
 - An effort toward two-way communications

What is radio, anyway?

- First era: One source to many listeners (Broadcasting)
- Many to one: Many sources that you choose (YouCasting)
- Many to many: Your social channels share what they find interesting (Crowdcasting)



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


How do we pay for it?

- Freemium
 - Limited service or ad-supported for free
 - Paid upgrades
 - Example: Pandora, Google Play
- Paid services
 - You pay for access to the service
 - Examples: Satellite radio, Apple Music
- Tied to other services
 - You buy something and get the service.
 - Example: Amazon Prime and Music
- All ad-supported
