






What is copyrightable in a virtual reality world?

Two key patent cases

- Alice Corp. v. CLS Bank International (2014) [SCOTUS Link]
- Establishes de facto software patents by adding an "inventive concept" to a patentable product
- Mayo Collaborative Services Inc. v. Prometheus Laboratories Inc. (2012) [SCOTUS Link]
 - While invalidating a diagnostic patent held by Prometheus Laboratories, SCOTUS ruled that the patent simply applied the laws of nature in its testing.

- •Ford leads the global automotive industry in patent innovation, due in large part to successful R&D efforts in autonomous driving.





What is a Notice of Allowance?

A Notice of Allowance is a document sent to a <u>patent</u> applicant from the United States Patent and <u>Trademark</u> Office (USPTO) after a <u>patent examiner</u> has decided to issue the requested patent.
